- ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Any registered architect, union accredited mason contractor, or supplier may enter projects.
- 2) Projects may only be entered twice over a four year period.
- 3) Architectural projects must be constructed and completed during the period of Jan. 1st, 2015 and June 1st, 2019 and must be constructed predominately of masonry, including stone, which is exposed to view.
- 4) Projects must be located in Northern and Central Illinois or Northwest Indiana as designated by the following counties: Boone, Bureau, Carroll, Champaign, Coles, Cook, JoDaviess, DeKalb, Douglas, DuPage, Edgar, Ford, Grundy, Henry, Kankakee, Kane, Kendall, Iroqouis, Lake, LaSalle, Lee, Livingston, McHenry, Ogle, Piatt, Putnam, Stark, Stephenson, Vermillion, Whiteside, Will and Winnebago in Illinois and Lake, Jasper, Newton LaPorte. Porter and Starke in Indiana.

- REGISTRATION -

ENTRY FEE: \$100.00 for the first project, \$50 for each additional entry. Each licensed, practicing architect may attend the event free of charge with one complimentary quest. Pre-registration will be required.

Requested complimentary tickets will be sent to all entrants. Additional tickets for the event will be available online at www.MasonrvAdvisorvCouncil/ExcellenceinMasonrv. The cost for each ticket is \$50.00.

CLASSIFICATION: For purposes of jury procedure only, projects are to be classified by the entrant as project pertains to the following categories.

HOUSING (Single Family/Urban) **RELIGIOUS HOUSING** (Multi-Family) **CONTEMPORARY REHAB** GOVERNMENTAL **EDUCATIONAL** INDUSTRIAL/COMMERCIAL MISCELLANEOUS

HEALTH CARE/SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH MIXED USE ENTRY

(part commercial, part housing, for example) should be classified according to the larger overall function

- SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Each project must be submitted in the following manner:

ONLY COMPLETE STRUCTURES. PREDOMINANTLY OF MASONRY INCLUDING STONE. WHICH IS EXPOSED TO VIEW, WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR JUDGING.

To enhance the projects' presentation at judging, photographs should be clear and professional in quality. Remember that our judges can only award you for the things they can see in the photographs - they cannot visit your project in person.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPH REQUIREMENTS

Submit no more than 10 images and no less than 6 images per project. Files are to be identified (and lettered a, b, c...) in the sequence in which they will be shown to the jury.

File formats should be .jpg images or .tif as long as they are not over-compressed - set compression levels to yield highest quality.

Images must be high resolution originals, (no cell phone images) not to exceed 5 megapixels capacity and is best left to a professional photographer.

Please arrange for professional photos to be taken while weather permits. If you need a photographer, the Masonry Advisory Council can provide a contact for you, however we will not absorb the cost. Photographer referral can be obtained by calling our office at 847-297-6704.

A signed release must be obtained from your photographer for permission to duplicate all copy right photos for publicity use.

Within the ten images to be submitted, the following information must be included.

- A) Overall view of structure.
- B) Four elevations of exterior (where applicable).
- C) View of interior (where applicable).
- D) Special masonry details, of stone, granite, limestone, marble etc.

If contemporary rehab/restoration classification, include 2 different images of building prior to rehabilitation.

Do not submit any materials which are not required. Data sheet must be filled out completely. We reserve the right to disqualify any entry with incomplete information or visual materials.

Each digital image must be identified with project name.

All images and data sheets become the sole property of the Illinois/Indiana Masonry Council and WILL NOT BE RETURNED. All materials submitted may be used by MAC to publicize the entries.
